

Timeline of dispute between Tina Rothery and Cuadrilla

7 August 2014

Occupation at 5am by 26 people opposed to fracking of a field off Preston New Road, Little Plumpton, near Blackpool. [Press release](#)

12 August 2014

Camp joined by what eventually became about 100 members of Reclaim the Power

14 August 2014

Landowner [reportedly](#) instructs lawyers to take action to recover possession of the land

22 August 2014

Cuadrilla issued a statement saying it had served a claim for possession against trespassers

26 August 2014

Anti-fracking campaigners say they vacated field

27 August 2014

Cuadrilla says the final campaigner leaves the field and date set for eviction on behalf of Cuadrilla and landowners

28 August 2014

David Hodge, judge at Manchester High Court, imposes a possession order for the campsite and a temporary injunction at current and future land surrounding Cuadrilla's proposed exploration sites. The court adjourns a final decision on the injunction until 8 October 2014 to give more time for people who oppose it to read the papers.

8 October 2014

Court hearing in Manchester confirms unopposed an injunction on people entering the Preston New Road land (and other sites) until 28 days after planning permission was granted or 8 October 2016. A single named defendant, Tina Rothery, appears in court. Cuadrilla claimed costs against her.

29 January 2015

Tina Rothery offers to pay £500 of the costs.

10 February 2015

Eversheds law firm, on behalf of two Cuadrilla companies and 10 landowners, rejects the offer.

6 May 2015

High Court in Manchester issues final costs certificate against Tina Rothery of £51,594.53.

26 May 2015

On behalf of Cuadrilla and 10 landowners, Eversheds requests payment of costs within 14 days.

3 May 2016

Blackpool District Registry issues order to Tina Rothery to attend Blackpool Law Courts to "provide information about her means and other information needed to enforce the judgement." This follows an application by the claimant (Cuadrilla and the landowners). The costs now stand at £55,342.37

24 June 2016

Tina Rothery required to attend Blackpool District Registry, The Law Courts, Chapel Street, Blackpool, FY1 5RJ at 10am.
